Camping Guidelines

- Riverpond group campsite offers primitive camping only. There are no water hook-ups on site.
- There are no dumping facilities for water or waste. Please do not drain gray water anywhere onto the ground.
- Please put all garbage in plastic bags and deposit in trash receptacles.
- Restrooms will be available on the grounds.
- Parking-We allow parking in designated areas. Carpooling is strongly encouraged.
- Profanity and excessive noise will not be tolerated at any time. **Fireworks, firearms, mini-bikes, smoking or drugs are never allowed anywhere on the premises.**
- Please be courteous to your neighbors at all times and observe quiet hours between 10pm and 8am in the camping area. Remember that many families will be resting during these hours.
- Respect your neighbors by not walking through occupied campsites. Keep music to a level that is heard only on your site.
- This is a family friendly event so please dress appropriately at all times.
- No Pets are only allowed in Camping area
- Fires should be attended at all times and remember to put your fire out completely. Use designated Fire Rings only. You must also clean up all bricks, ashes and all remnants of your campfire.
- Food will be available for purchase during designated times in the town of Crouch, a 10 minute walk from the campground.

- Continue through town and an additional 5 miles to find Cascade Raft & Kayak on the left side of Highway 55 after the road widens into 4 lanes.
